MICROPIGMENTATION AFTERCARE

Procedure	Swelling	Moisture & Hygiene	Avoid for 2 Weeks	Remarks
Eyebrows Eyeliner Lips	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Swelling depends on the location of the treated area. If the procedure is on the face or head, try sleeping propped up on your back to reduce swelling. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Keep The procedure area lightly moist using a healing balm for 2 weeks. Apply The healing Balm when washing and showering. Use Cotton buds to apply any products. Clean using the micro foam wash. If the surface appears crusty, DO NOT force removal by picking, scratching or washing (You will remove pigment with crust). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Chemical Soaps, and cleansers. Wash around the procedure area. Moisturizers, skin creams, and Make Up. Picking and touching. Sun and tanning beds. Chlorine pools, Jacuzzi, and saunas. Hot, steamy, long showers. Shower with your back to the water spray to avoid water and product getting onto treatment area. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> DO NOT be alarmed by darkness in the procedure area. The final colour cannot be assessed until at least four weeks after the procedure. DO NOT be alarmed by colour coming off when applying topical ointment. Seek Medical attention if you have signs of extreme redness or puss.
<p>Important Notes: Remember that your selected colour will be stronger and sharply defined for 4-6 days and shedding away as though no or little colour is present. Over the following 2 weeks your colour will blossom and become softer. The process is normally up to 14 days, however, it can be prolonged if your immune system is compromised. Keep in mind that unevenness of colour can be expected. This is why we have a control\top up visit to perfect the work carried out in your original appointment. This session is charged separately from the initial procedure. Any cancellation without a 48hour notice, and no shows will be charged the full cost of the session.</p>		<p>Long Term Care:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a good sunscreen on a daily basis. If you are planning to undergo any chemical peel, MRI, or other medical procedures, please tell the operator that you have received a Medical Tattoo. If you donate blood, it is a standard policy that you must wait at least one year after any Tattooing procedure. Check with the organisation dealing with you, before donating. If you are planning to have Laser or IPL hair removal, you MUST tell the operator that you have a Medical Tattoo. This is essential as these devices can pull the pigment back. 		

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
